Ready infrastructure in the Smart City

The Solid Waste Collection Facility



Comprising 15 Km Vacuum Solid Waste conveying system, programmable Logic Controller system with 4 fractions of waste segregated at source- the first in East and Central Africa in a City Scale.

The Water Treatment Plant



Fresh water treatment facilities with an Output capacity 7.5 Million litres per day expandable to 62 Million litres treatment capacity. It has storage capacity of 13 Million litres of potable water.

The Wastewater Reclamation Facility



Waste-water reclamation facility for city wastewater management with a capacity of 6 Million litres recycling up to 90% of the water for reuse purposes.

Silicon Savannah Intelligent Operations Centre



A core component hub that manage the Konza Technopolis smart city's operations and infrastructure leveraging data and technology to improve efficiency and services.

The Power Distribution Substation



The Konza smart Distribution Substation with a capacity of 120 MW. It uses the latest technology in safety by employing gas insulation allowing it to have a minimal footprint and high capacity.

The Furnished Apartments



28 units Furnished apartment block currently completed and ready to let.

The Silicon Savannah Experience Centre



A centre for visitors to experience the technology and infrastructure of the Konza Technopolis smart city. It serves as a demonstration site for the city's smart features, such as its data centre, waste water reclamation facility, and security systems.

The Streetscape and Subsurface Utilities



Elaborate streetscapes comprising of over 40 km of, road network, street lighting, landscaping of streets and parks starring a green transit corridor to enable both motorised and non-motorised transport in the city and a fully-fledged Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Corridor.

Utility network for smart city standards comprising 170 km Drainage and water supply system; 15 km Irrigation and reuse System; 6 km Utility Tunnel containing fibre optic network, electrical network, power systems, solid waste management, drainage and water supply system among others.

Konza Technopolis at a glance

Konza Technopolis is a 5000-acre smart city, strategically located in Konza, 67 kilometers from Nairobi along the Nairobi-Mombasa highway.

As a key flagship project of Kenya's Vision 2030, Konza Technopolis aims to contribute towards the transformation of Kenya into a newly industrializing, middle-income county providing a high quality of life to all its citizens in a clean and secure environment.

Konza Technopolis is master planned as a 'work-live-and-play' location. The land is zoned for various uses, including technology, education, residential, commercial, mixed-use developments and light industry, ensuring strategic alignment with investor needs.

Investors get flexible leasing terms of up to 90 years, providing security of tenor for long-tenor investments.

The Technopolis features the 1,000-acre wildlife corridor, open parks and green spaces which provide natural open areas for residents and workers.

Currently, Konza Technopolis has over 70 investors, who include local and foreign enterprises, corporate entities, joint ventures, government agencies, and individuals.

In July 2025, the Kenya Civil

Aviation Authority (KCAA) officially gazetted Konza Technopolis as the country's first National Drone Corridor.

At full completion, Konza Technopolis is projected to be home to at least 240,000 direct residents.

The Konza One Stop Shop is a fully integrated service centre designed to facilitate investment end-to-end under one roof. The centre facilitates investors to obtain approvals, licenses, permits and incentives, allowing them to complete their entire investment journey without physically visiting multiple offices.

World-class infrastructure

The Phase I developments that were launched last week include underground utility tunnels, a waste-water reclamation facility, a water treatment plant that treats water to WHO portable standards, a vacuum-enabled solid waste collection system, the Konza Experience Centre, 40km of streetscape, an athletes field and furnished apartments, among others

A rapidly developing academia, research and innovation hub

Konza Technopolis hosts three Universities – Open University of Kenya, Kenya Advanced Institute of



Science and Technology, and Riara University. The education band allows for other developments, from tertiary level to postgraduate and advanced levels.

Digital transformation

Konza Technopolis hosts a fully operational, Tier III certified National Data Centre, which provides high-quality cloud computing services to both government institutions and private enterprises.

This infrastructure supports the storage and processing power needed for data-driven innovation.

Konza has collaborated with partners to deliver over 300 digital hubs present in all the 47 counties.

KoTDA launched the Silicon Savannah Woman, an initiative to empower women across diverse sectors, including business, technology, and the creative industry.

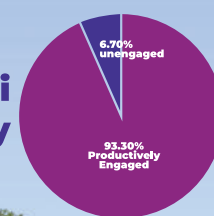
